COVID 19 Policy for Practices and Games

Practices will be conducted as follows:

- All players and coaches will have a temperature check before entering the gym. If you are sick, please stay home. Anyone who arrives with a fever or is showing signs of sickness, will not be permitted into the building.
- All will be required to wear a mask. We will have some light weight masks available for the players on the first day of practice. They will only be given out once. The player is free to wear their own mask. There is still some grey area, from the state, as to the requirement to wear them on the court during play. This requirement will be assessed as we go along.
- While it will be a challenge to fully social distance while playing sports. it will be practiced to the best of our ability.
- There will be hand sanitizer available and soap in the bathrooms for hand washing.
- The volleyballs will be wiped down frequently.
- Parents will not be able to attend practice.

Games: All the above procedures will be followed plus these additional procedures:

- Only OBCA parents of players will be allowed to attend home games. They will be subject to a temperature check. Parents will not be permitted to attend away games. Only visiting team players, coaches and drivers will be allowed in the gym. The visiting team and coaches will have temperatures taken before entering the gym. Anyone with a fever or who is showing signs of illness will not be permitted in the building.
- Game balls will be wiped down frequently.

Open Bible Christian Academy is fully committed to make this Volleyball season as safe as we possibly can and prevent the spread of this virus. With that said, it will be each parent's choice to have their child participate. We cannot guarantee that your child will not be exposed to COVID or any other illnesses.
